RETRO-REPRODUCTION MODEL 602 AR15

I decided to sell my “original” 602 model AR15. This was a project featured in America’s Gun: The Practical AR15, and it was also featured in GUNS Magazine. I built a retro-reproduction M16A1 also, and that is the one I wanted, so this one is now up for sale.



It is just as close to a 1959 original as I could get. All parts are new, many are genuine GI surplus (all also in new condition). Barrel is an original 1-12 twist chrome lined, correct with original three-prong flash hider. Receivers are perfect reproductions or the original style lower and upper by Nodak-Spud and completely correct, including the gray finish. This receiver set is absolutely beautiful. Bolt carrier group is USGI chrome plated, slick-side. Furniture is accurate reproduction from new parts. I can’t say for sure that all the pieces-parts are era-correct, but they are original and I did my best in finish-matching. It was also assembled carefully with every detail addressed.

The gun is unfired. It’s nice!

Ships with era-correct web sling (new reproduction) and two Vietnam-era 20-round aluminum magazines.
